



WHAT YOUR BUSINESS NEEDS TO KNOW

MANDATORY VMS REGISTRATION

Following the 2025–2026 National Budget Announcement by Hon. Prof. Biman Prasad on 27 June 2025, the Fiji Revenue & Customs Service (FRCS) has issued an important clarification on VAT Monitoring System (VMS) registration requirements that may impact your business.

What's New?

FRCS has confirmed that:

- VMS registration is now mandatory for businesses with an annual turnover of \$50,000 or more and operating under Phases 1 to 3 of the implementation schedule.
- The VAT threshold remains unchanged at \$100,000.

VMS Implementation Timeline

Phase	Industries Affected	Registration Deadline
Phase 1	Supermarkets & Pharmacies	31st December 2025
Phase 2	Medical Centres, Travel Agencies, Accounting Firms, Law Firms, Hardware Companies	31st December 2025
Phase 3	To be announced in Government Gazette	TBA

Note: If your business is not listed in the phases but you wish to voluntarily comply, you may contact FRCS.
